Murray Gold^o

Murray lives both in New York and London with studios in both cities.

Murray is one of the most inspired and uncompromising composers in his field. He has scored a number of British and American films. Most recent US commissions include the scores for two very different feature films; The Weinstein Company's animated feature HOODWINKED TOO! HOOD VS. EVIL and director Emily Young's gripping feature adaptation of Paulo Coelho's novel VERONIKA DECIDES TO DIE. Prior to these films Murray scored the incredibly funny DEATH AT A FUNERAL, directed by Frank Oz and distributed by MGM.

From his ground-breaking BAFTA-nominated score of VANITY FAIR to the RTS Award-winning soundtrack of QUEER AS FOLK Murray Gold has been the composer of choice for the most innovative programmes on television. Murray started his career as a writer for radio and theatre before making his mark as a composer. Murray is perhaps best-known for his score to the hugely popular DOCTOR WHO series whose soundtrack albums are best sellers on iTunes and in stores. Murray's music has played a significant part in the successful re-invention of the series.

Murray has also created, arranged and orchestrated two special live concerts for the music from DOCTOR WHO. The first, DOCTOR WHO: A CELEBRATION, was played at the Millenium Centre in Cardiff in 2006; the second, the DOCTOR WHO PROM, was part of the BBC PROMS in July 2008 at the Royal Albert Hall in London.

Murray's music for DOCTOR WHO - A CHRISTMAS CAROL, aired on Christmas Day 2010, following Series 5, which saw the arrival of the new Doctor, played by Matt Smith. Murray continues to record and mix his compositions for Series 6 of this wonderful TV series for the BBC, to be aired in 2011.

Murray is also about to embark on Series 4 of DOCTOR WHO spin-off TORCHWOOD, starring John Barrowman, and six part crime drama SCOTT AND BAILEY for ITV1.
